Favourable outcome of cassation appeal filed by Famur Finance with the Supreme Administrative Court

Text of the report:

Further to Current Reports Nos. 87 and 88 of 22 December 2017 and Current Report No. 11 of 19 February 2018, the Management Board of Grenevia S.A. (“Grenevia”) announces that it has today received the Supreme Administrative Court’s decision to grant the cassation appeal brought by Famur Finance sp. z o.o., a subsidiary of Grenevia, against the judgment entered by of the Provincial Administrative Court of Gliwice on 23 December 2019 on Famur Finance sp. z o.o.’s complaint against the Head of the Katowice Fiscal Administration’s refusal, dated 21 May 2019, to acknowledge an overpayment of value added tax for October 2013, whereby the lower court’s judgment’s was reversed in its entirety.

Accordingly, the Grenevia Group has recognised in its consolidated finance income for 2024 the amount of PLN 17 million, representing unduly paid interest on value added tax for October 2013, plus interest payable on this amount.
